

Electronic Monitoring Cases with Warrants

June 2026

On June 1, 2026, there were 303 total electronic monitoring (EM) cases in warrant status, accounting for about 10% of the 3,014 EM cases active on that day (Table 1).

Table 2 breaks down the inclusion zone cases by the most serious charge attached to the case at the time of the EM order. Top charges for domestic violence exclusion zone cases are not included, as those are exclusively domestic battery or other intimate partner violence charges. This accounts for the difference between the 303 cases in Table 1 and the 236 cases in Table 2.

Key points:

- The increase in warrant numbers since January 2026 reflects updated protocols – lower violation thresholds and extended judicial review on weekends and holidays – resulting in improved detection and faster action, not an increase in overall violation rates
- 72% of warrants involve non-violent charges
- Retail theft, theft, and aggravated battery are the three largest groups, accounting for 31% of warrants for inclusion zone cases
