

OBTAINING A SUMMONS FOR CRIMINAL CHARGES (No Domestic Relationship)

When you report a crime and an arrest is not made, you may go in person to the appropriate court listed below to request that criminal proceedings be initiated by way of a summons. Bring your Victim Information Notice and any other relevant information, such as the offender's name, date of birth/age, physical description, and home address to the summons officer assigned to the court between 8:30 am and 11:30 am Monday through Friday (excluding court holidays). The summons officer will then assist you in the process of obtaining the summons.
