DUI Evaluation Appointment

Please provide prior to your appointment the following documents: (Failure to attend your appointment or reschedule within 48 hours will result in a \$50.00 rescheduling fee.)

All arrest documents, (items 1 through 4) can be attached to the DocuSign Packet, (instructions included in packet), or email to <u>SSD.DUleval@cookcountyil.gov</u>.

- 1. TICKETS from day of arrest;
- 2. LAW ENFORCEMENT SWORN REPORT- this indicates breathalyzer score or refusal to submit to chemical/breathalyzer testing;
- **3. TOXICOLOGY RESULTS** If blood or urine toxicology testing was performed at a hospital or facility on the day of arrest documentation of these results must be provided;
- 4. COURT PURPOSE DRIVING ABSTRACT (RECORD CANNOT BE MORE THAN 30 DAYS OLD FROM APPOINTMENT DATE) Obtain this record online at <u>www.ilsos.gov</u> or at a Secretary of State Office with a valid I.D. and current fee;
- 5. MEDICATIONS Please have list of your current medications, both prescribed and over the counter, you are taking or were taking on the day of the arrest;
- 6. PICTURE I.D. Driver license, State I.D., passport, school I.D., or employee I.D.;
- 7. \$250 FEE TO RECEIVE COPY OF EVALUATION Payment arrangements at time of appointment. Reduced fee provided to qualified indigents that produce proof of income.
- 8. PRIOR TREATMENT DOCUMENTATION Substance abuse or mental health documentation including assessments, discharge summaries, and diagnosis.
