

NOTICE TO PEOPLE ACTING AS THEIR OWN ATTORNEYS

A person acting on his or her own behalf as an attorney is, under the law, held to the same standards and duties as an attorney admitted to practice in the State of Illinois. You are expected to know what the law requires and how to accomplish your purpose in accordance with the applicable statutes and court rules. No Court employee is obligated to tell you what you have to do, how you are to do it or what you should do under the circumstances. In fact, the Judges, the Clerks, the Sheriff's Deputies, and all Court personnel are specifically prohibited by statute from giving you legal advice and can be fined for doing so. If you need advice, please see an attorney. If you do not have a lawyer and do not know a specific lawyer, contact the Chicago Bar Association. If you do not have the funds to pay an attorney, you can seek assistance from the Legal Aid Bureau - United Charities of Chicago, The Legal Assistance Foundation of Chicago, or The Legal Assistance Foundation, Inc. of Cook County.

The Clerk of the Circuit Court is not required to provide and does not carry a complete stock of preprinted pleading forms. Certain limited forms, general in nature, are available and will be provided as needed.

CARPLS also operates a domestic relations self-help desk. Eligible clients can get a consultation with one of CARPLS' advice desk attorneys on any domestic relations matter, whether pre-decree or post-decree. The services at the desk include document preparation for simple uncontested divorces, which meet CARPLS' criteria for an appropriate pro se divorce. The desk is located on the 30th floor of the Daley Center and is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

It also provides information and referral, community education, and linkage to social services provided by their parent agency, Metropolitan Family Services.

Clients must live in Cook County or have a pending case in a downtown Chicago domestic relations courtroom. Prospective clients call intake directly to discuss case type and financial eligibility. Appointments with attorneys or paralegals will be scheduled as appropriate. LAB does not handle criminal, juvenile or traffic court offenses or other types of civil law problems such as housing, consumer, bankruptcy, or collection cases.
