SUBJECT: TAX VALUATION PROCEEDINGS

NEWLY FILED CASES: Effective immediately, the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois shall cause all newly filed tax valuation complaints to be randomly assigned to Calendar 11.

PENDING CASES: All cases previously assigned to Calendar 4 will remain pending on Calendar 4 for the purpose of entering orders of dismissal, re-designation of the matter or assignment to one of the several Calendars as a "Small Claim." Thus, all matters relating to such cases shall be scheduled for hearing on Calendar 4 until the necessary order is entered.

MOTIONS TO CONSOLIDATE: Any party seeking to consolidate a newly filed valuation objection case with a previously filed valuation objection case shall schedule such Motion for hearing on Calendar 11. The judge presiding on that Calendar may enter an order consolidating such cases into the earlier filed matter. If the earlier filed case was assigned to and remains pending on Calendar 4, the Court, in addition to the Order of Consolidation, shall transfer the consolidated matter to Calendar 11.
