Upon the filing of such a petition, the Clerk of Court shall cause a Notice of Hearing containing the date, time and location (facility name, common street address and courtroom number) to be created for service on the Respondent, the Respondent's attorney, if any, Respondent's Guardian, if any, any responsible relative and the Director of the facility where the Respondent is being evaluated. (405 ILCS 5/3-706). The Order shall be in substantially the form as Exhibit A, attached hereto.

The State's Attorney of Cook County, Illinois as attorney for the Petitioners shall be responsible for effecting service of the notice on those persons entitled to notice.
