Such certificate constitutes compliance with the affidavit requirement set forth in Rule 10.3 (b) 6.

No Application for Order Directing the Issuance of a tax Deed filed on or after January 2, 2008 will be entertained by the Court unless it complies with the format as set out in Exhibit A to this Administrative Order.
