ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2008 - 11

**SUBJECT: Assignment of Administrative Matters concerning the November 2008;
General Election; Assignment of Emergency matters relating to the
November, 2008 General Election.**

All matters relating to the administration or conduct of the November 2008 General Election by the Board of Elections of the City of Chicago filed on or after the date of this Order shall be assigned by the Clerk of Court to Calendar 5 in the County Division. This Order shall control the assignment of cases regardless of whether the filing is made by the Board of Elections or any other person or party.

On November 4, 2008, Election Day, the County Division shall be in session from 7:00 a.m. until the Presiding Judge determines it is no longer necessary to be in session. The Court will entertain election related matters only. The Court will not, pursuant to the Order of the Chief Judge, be in session to hear or review any other matter, nor will the Clerk's Office be open to accept filings in any other case type. All cases relating to the conduct of the November 2008 General Election filed on November 4, 2008 shall be assigned as follows:

- A) Even Numbered Cases filed between 11:00 a.m. and 1:30p.m shall be assigned to Calendar 6;
 - B) Odd Numbered Cases filed between 11:00 a.m. and 1:30p.m shall be assigned to Calendar 11;
 - C) Even Numbered Cases filed between 1:30 p.m. and the recess of the November 4, 2008 session shall be assigned to Calendar 7;
 - B) Odd Numbered Cases filed between 1:30 p.m. and the recess of the November 4, 2008 session shall be assigned to Calendar 3.
- Commencing November 5, 2008, all newly filed cases relating to elections shall be randomly assigned under procedures currently in effect.
