In order to allow time for the preparation of necessary court papers, persons seeking hearings on such matters should plan at arriving at the Office of the Cook County State's Attorney, Room 3130, George W. Dunne Administration Building, 69 W. Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois no later than 9:30 a.m for the morning call and 1:00 p. m. for the afternoon call.

In addition, The Court will entertain such Petitions at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday in the court facility located within the Chicago Read Mental Health Facility, Building K, 4200 N. Oak Park Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. They will also be entertained on Tuesday of each week at 10:30 a.m. at the court facility



Persons seeking hearings on such matters should plan arriving at the designated court facility no later than 9:00 a.m. to allow for the preparation of necessary court papers.

Please note that the notice requirements of 405 ILCS 3-701(b) will be enforced.
