GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 2026 - 10

RE: Elder Law Cases


Effective July 1, 2026, all judges assigned to hear felony matters in the Circuit Court of Cook County shall be assigned to hear Elder Law and Miscellaneous Remedies (ELMR) cases arising within the geographical boundaries of their respective Municipal Districts.

Such assignments are intended to promote the efficient administration of justice, enhance accessibility for litigants, and ensure the timely disposition of ELMR matters throughout Cook County. Judges assigned to these matters shall exercise the authority conferred by law and applicable Supreme Court Rules with respect to ELMR proceedings originating within their district.

The Presiding Judges of the Municipal Districts, in consultation with the Office of the Chief Judge, shall implement procedures necessary to effectuate these assignments and ensure the orderly transfer, scheduling, and disposition of ELMR cases.
